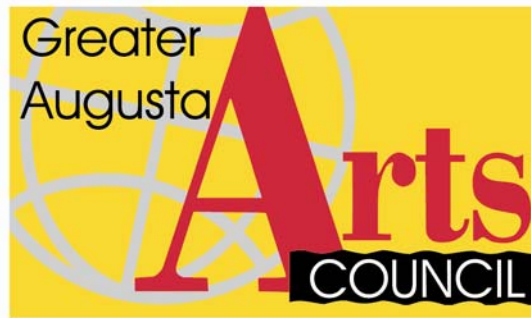

We encourage you to be creative with the crafts & remind you to consider the materials necessary to complete the entire weekend. You will receive an estimated **3,000+ children** during the festival!



## Answers to Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) of the Festival

1. Information relating to Arts in the Heart of Augusta will be available in late spring at [www.artsintheheart.com](http://www.artsintheheart.com).
2. Each group should plan on staffing their booth during ALL festival hours. If your organization needs additional volunteers, please contact **Kylan Swain** at [artsed@augustaarts.com](mailto:artsed@augustaarts.com) or 706-826-4702 ext. 3, providing an estimated number of volunteers needed.
3. While your craft/activity should have a theme related to the “**Country of Origin**”, you do not provide any *information* about your “**country**”. This is simply a name for the youngsters to check-off on their **passports**, as they make their way around the Children's Area.
4. The Greater Augusta Arts Council does not pay for craft/activity materials – each group is responsible for proving all supplies necessary for their activity. **Please note:** You are not required to provide a “take away” craft. You can provide games/activities that correspond with your “country”. Also, should you choose to provide a “take away” craft, you are allowed to solicit sponsorships to help pay for the cost of supplies.
5. **Organizational Banners** are suggested for each tent. If you do not have a banner, please contact **Kylan Swain** at [artsed@augustaarts.com](mailto:artsed@augustaarts.com) or 706-826-4702 ext. 3. Please hang each banner at the back of your tent – this is to prevent banners being hung from the front of the tent, blocking the view of what's inside the tent. We will have extra zip-ties if needed.
6. **We can provide tents.** If you have a tent, please let us know. In addition to each **10X10 tent**, the festival will provide each group with two 8 ft. long rectangle tables and 5 chairs. If you will need additional chairs, please contact **Kylan Swain** at [artsed@augustaarts.com](mailto:artsed@augustaarts.com) or 706-826-4702 ext. 3.
7. If you need electricity, you will need to **bring your own extension cords**. Lights will be provided.



8. For 2010, the Children's Area will most likely be located next to the family stage. The festival map is undergoing a huge change this year as our site near the bulkhead has become a construction lay-down area for the new TEE Center and parking deck. We are excited our City is moving forward on these projects; we are facing the challenge of new placement for the festival with great optimism. We anticipate the children's area will be located on or near 8<sup>th</sup> street and the Family stage. The final decision on location will come in late summer 2010.
9. This festival is rain or shine – please plan accordingly.
10. You are allowed (and encouraged!) to **hand out information about your group** and talk with parents about activities available for their children within your organization (if applicable).
